

SH20 COMMUNITY DESIGN OF THE GLOUCESTER PARK INTERCHANGE



Features:

- New shoreline of reclaimed land can be used to accommodate underground ducts for existing & new transmission lines and allows realignment of SH20 away from the Onehunga pond.
- Pedestrian over bridge would connect the old Onehunga shoreline with the harbour and the very popular coast to coast walk.
- Gloucester Park interchange would be constructed as an underpass to reduce its negative visual impact and would provide an unrestricted view of the Manukau Harbour for visitors arriving in Auckland City.
- Sea Scouts and the Cruising Club relocated onto the all tide ramp to allow unrestricted access to the harbour.
- The new shoreline incorporates the original features prior to reclamation of the harbour and is based on the ARC's Ambury Farm shoreline.
- Provides a large recreational area for citizens to access the harbour and participate in water based activities.

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
